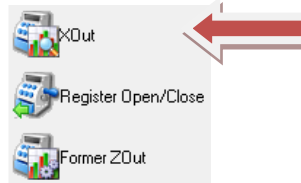
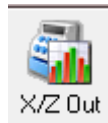




How to use Flash Sales In Retail Pro Version 9

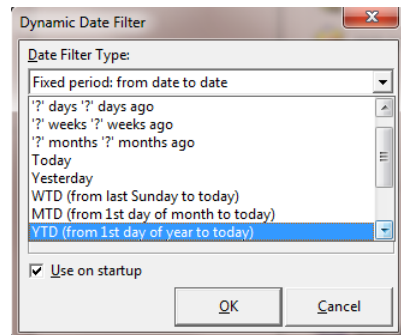
Sometimes it is useful to see your sales information in a graph format. For those times, you will need to use Flash Sales.

1. Go to **X/Z Out** on the top menu and choose **XOut**.

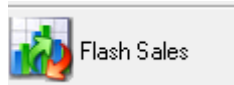


2. Now set up your time frame. Whenever possible, we recommend using a “Dynamic” date range. In this example, we are going to use **YTD** (year to date).

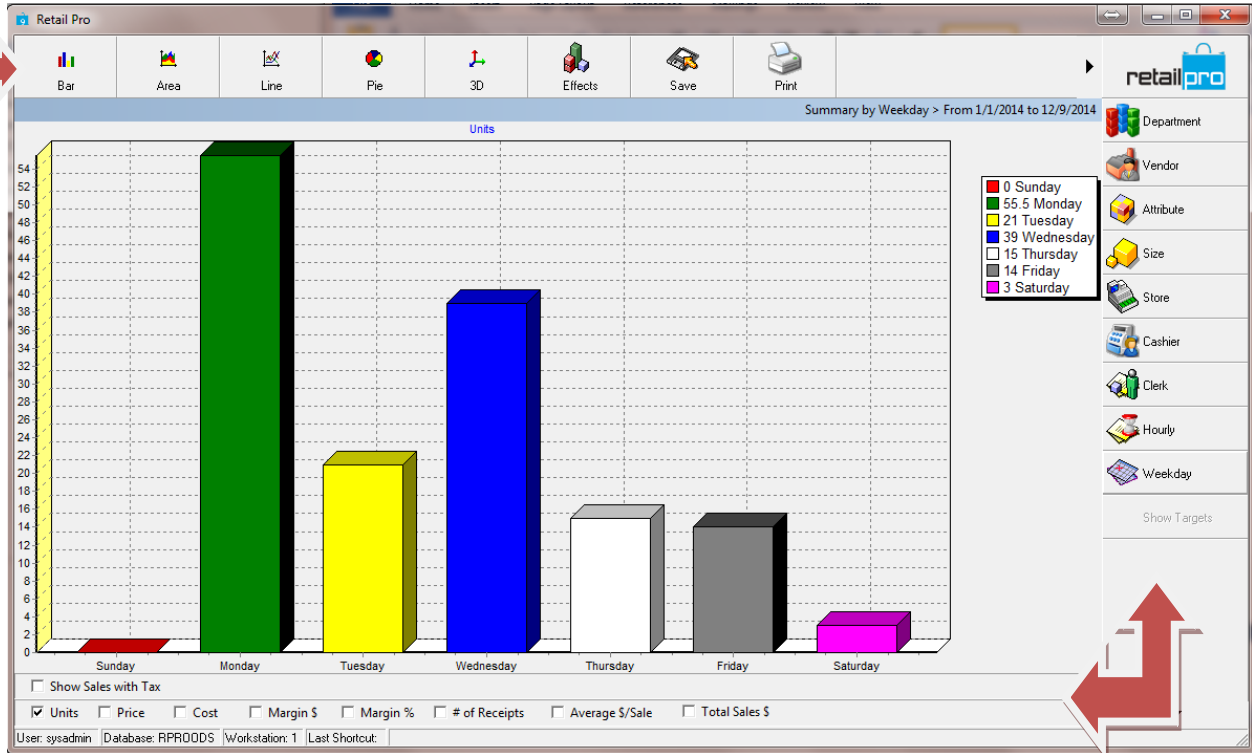


3. Now go to **FLASH SALES** on the side menu.



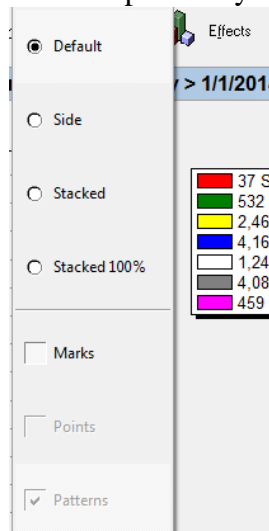
4. You should now have a sales chart on your screen. There are 3 areas you can alter for your needs:

- Type of chart – Bar, pie, line, etc
- What the sales are based on – Dept, Vendor, clerk, etc
- What value you want in the chart – Units sold, Price, Cost, etc



5. In our example, we are looking at YTD sales by weekday and units sold.

6. You can also change the effect or patterns you see in the chart



7. There is also the ability to print these charts by using the **PRINT** button along the top menu.
